**Description of Services:** Generations goal is to create a warm, home like setting in which to provide a specialized treatment for abusive behaviors. It was established in 1991, the program initially served 12 boys, ages 10-19, and quickly increased to over 20 boys by the end of 1992. In 1996, a step down program was added to bridge the gap and help ease the transition for the boys from the highly structured High Management program back into their homes and communities and allow for them to use the skills that they have acquired while being closely supervised. In 1998, Generations expanded to add the Alternative Treatment Program, expressly for the boys involved with (DJJ) Department of Juvenile Justice. This program houses 26 boys and specializes in treatment for criminal behavior problems, an especially challenging cycle of abusive behaviors.

**Hours of Operation:** 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

**Population served:** Males, 10-19 years of age

**Cost to Clients:** Varies, depending on method of referral and ability to pay
