PASCAL DELIVERS

What is "PASCAL Delivers"?

PASCAL Delivers is an online system that gives students and employees of South Carolina's colleges the ability to request books from any other college or university library in the state.

Library users may request books independently using the instructions provided in this brochure, or they may ask for assistance from the library staff. Requested books typically arrive at the user's home college within just a few business days.

Who can borrow books using PASCAL Delivers?

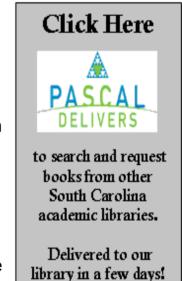
Current students, faculty, and staff at Piedmont Technical College can use PASCAL Delivers. Patrons must be "in good standing" at the PTC Library in order to use the service.

PASCAL Delivers puts over 12 million volumes and 4 million unique titles in easy reach!

How do I use PASCAL Delivers?

First, search PTC's library catalog to learn whether a book is locally available. If it is not, follow these steps:

- From inside PTC's catalog, click on the PASCAL Delivers image (shown here).
- 2. In the PASCAL Delivers catalog, type your search terms and indicate the type of search that you want to try (i.e. title, author, keyword, etc.).
- 3. Locate the book that you want and click on the title to access details.



- 4. Click "Display Holdings" to make sure that the book is available, then click "Request this Item."
- 5. Select your home college (PTC), then enter your full name and PTC ID Number (P#). The library staff will call you when your items arrive at PTC.
