Begin your research by locating books with general information about your topic. Check the library's catalog to find books.

How to Do a Basic Search

Visit the Library Web site at <u>http://www.ptc.edu/library</u> and click on the **Library Catalog** link. Begin your search on the **Basic Search** page. Here, you can do different types of searches and access all types of information.

- 1. To begin, type a term in the search box.
- 2. To narrow a search, select one of the following options before clicking the **Search** button:
 - Keyword (word or phrase)
 - Author
 - Title
 - Subject
 - Series
 - Periodical title
- 3. Select a library to search in the Library box, or select Piedmont Technical College Libraries to include all branches in the search.
- Select PTC Libraries and E_RESOURCES to search for electronic books in addition to print books.

Remember to write down the whole call number!

DVDs & Videos

The Library loans most of its DVDs and VHS tapes to students; those that may not be loaned are clearly marked.

Students may borrow up to 2 of these items at a time and keep them for one week.

DVD/VHS players are available for use in the Library's Viewing Rooms and at the Laurens County Higher Education Center's LRC on a first come, first served basis.



- Use the Power Search option in the library catalog.
- Select either DVD or VHS Video format before submitting your search.

Big Tip

Write down words that show up again and again during your research! Academic Search Premier: PTC's premiere database with coverage of most academic topics including business and many other topics.

Business & Company Resource Center: Company profiles, histories, chronologies, and articles from international trade and business periodicals.

Business Source Premier:

Full- text access to 7,600 scholarly business journals and other sources that cover many business topics including management, economics, finance, accounting, and international business. **Custom Newspapers:** Access to full-text newspaper articles from the *New York Times* and other select U.S. and world newspapers.

General Business File

ASAP: 200,000 company profiles as well as 50,000 full text broker research reports, trade publications, newspapers, journals, and directory listings.

General Reference Center: General interest articles from magazines, reference books, and newspapers with many full-text entries and images.

Lexis-Nexis Academic: Includes full-text business information and news.

SIRS Knowledge Source: Offers full-text articles on social issues, health, business, science, government topics, the arts, and humanities.
