Alabama	<a href="#">Alabama Public Health</a>	<p>PTC's EMT program does not meet the educational requirements for licensure, registration, or certification in Alabama.</p> <p>A PTC EMT graduates must be Nationally Registered and complete an Alabama protocols course in order to apply for an Alabama EMSP license. If an Alabama Protocol class is needed, please contact a Regional Office. An online training course is available.</p>
Alaska	<a href="#">Alaska Department of Health and Social Services - Division of Public Health</a>	<p>PTC's EMT program meets the educational requirements for certification as an EMT-1 in Alaska. PTC EMT graduates are eligible to take the NREMT.</p> <p>As an out-of-state applicant, PTC EMS program graduates who hold current NREMT certification and show evidence of completing additional training as outlined in the Alaska Scope of Practice are eligible for reciprocity to the EMT-1 level.</p>
Arizona	<a href="#">Arizona Department of Health Services</a>	<p>PTC's EMT program meets the educational requirements for certification as an EMT in Arizona. PTC EMT graduates are eligible to take the NREMT.</p> <p>Arizona does not have reciprocal agreements with any other states; therefore, PTC EMS graduates cannot transfer SC certification to Arizona. Graduates applying for certification in Arizona are required to have a current and valid National Registry certification and an Arizona address. Arizona will not certify anyone initially at any level if they do not have a current and valid National Registry certification.</p>
Arkansas	<a href="#">Arkansas Department of Health</a>	<p>PTC's EMT program meets the educational requirements for licensure in Arkansas. PTC EMT graduates are eligible to take the NREMT.</p> <p>EMS graduates must pass a state and federal background check, have current and valid National Registry certification, and CPR certification to apply for licensure in Arkansas.</p>
California	<a href="#">California Emergency Medical Services Authority</a>	<p>PTC's EMT program meets the educational requirements for licensure in California. PTC EMT graduates are eligible to take the NREMT.</p> <p>Graduates who have passed the NREMT and received the EMT National Registry certificate may contact a local EMS agency to apply for EMT certification in California. A background check is required. The local EMS agency may require additional requirements to achieve licensure.</p>

PTC EMT graduates are eligible to take the NREMT.</p> <p>Graduates who have passed the NREMT and hold a current certification as a Emergency Medical Responder, have a current and valid CPR card, and complete a fingerprint-based background check are eligible to apply for licensure as an EMR in Colorado.</p>

PTC EMT graduates are eligible to take the NREMT.</p> <p>Graduates who have passed the NREMT are eligible to apply for EMR endorsement in Connecticut.</p>

PTC EMT graduates are eligible to take the NREMT.</p> <p>Graduates who have passed the NREMT meet partial requirements for becoming a licensed EMT in Delaware. Additional requirements are required. See the link for additional information regarding reciprocity if an EMT in another state.</p>

PTC EMT graduates are eligible to take the NREMT.</p> <p>Graduates who show proof of current NREMT certification and have certification in CPR are eligible to apply for EMT certification in Florida.</p>
Georgia	<a href="#">Georgia Department of Public Health</a>	<p>PTC's EMT program meets the educational requirements for licensure in Georgia. PTC EMT graduates are eligible to take the NREMT.</p> <p>Graduates with current NREMT certification at the EMR, EMT, AEMT or paramedic level are eligible to apply for licensure in Georgia.</p>

Reciprocity applicants validly certified/licensed as an "EMT" (2009 National Educational Standards) from any state/US territory and/or the NREMT will be permitted to obtain a New Jersey EMT certification without having to complete the refresher course or the state written examination.</p>
New Mexico	<a href="#">New Mexico Department of Health - Emergency Medical Systems Bureau</a>	<p>PTC's EMT meets the educational requirements for licensure in New Mexico. PTC EMT graduates are eligible to take the NREMT.</p> <p>To become licensed as an EMT in New Mexico, the applicant must have completed an EMT program and earned a successful pass on the NREMT.</p>
New York	<a href="#">New York State Department of Health - Emergency Medical Technician</a>	<p>PTC's EMT meets the educational requirements for licensure in New York. PTC EMT graduates are eligible to take the NREMT.</p> <p>Graduates with NREMT certification are eligible for certification in NY through reciprocity. Completed coursework must consist of 50% or more face-to-face delivery for lecture based courses.</p>

PTC EMT graduates are eligible to take the NREMT.</p> <p>Applicants currently holding EMS licenses/certifications from another state, or a National Registry certification may be issued a North Carolina EMS credential through the legal recognition process if they are an NC resident or are affiliated with an NC EMS agency.</p>

Applicants may be asked to submit fingerprinting and criminal record background checks, answer questions about past criminal convictions, submit additional documentation, pay licensure, certification, or registration fees, submit a Social Security number, abide by codes of conduct, or meet additional requirements not outlined in this document.

Applicants from out of states and the US territories are advised to review the information in the table and confirm EMT registration, certification, and licensing requirements in their home states/territories before enrolling in this or any educational program, as state and territory licensing requirements and boards or agency responsibilities may have changed since the information in this document was last updated.
